

DIRECTIONS...



From the West

Take I-39 to County D (north of Coloma, south of Stevens Point), then exit east toward Almond. Continue on D through Almond. Reach 14th Road 4 miles east of Almond. Turn right (south) and continue to Akron Drive (about 1.5 miles). Turn right, follow Akron $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to 14th Court. Follow the roadway left, and you will see the sign marking the entrance driveway to the Center. Turn right and proceed up the hill.

From the East

Take Route 41 to Oshkosh, WI. Turn west onto State Hwy. 21 and proceed to Wautoma (about 36 miles). On the west side of Wautoma, take State Highway 22 north towards Wild Rose. Follow 22 through Wild Rose, up two hills, to County P. Turn left on to P and continue about 3 miles to County AA, which joins P at that point. Go $\frac{1}{4}$ mile further on P, then take AA as it turns north (to the right), until you reach Akron Drive (1.5 miles). Take Akron Drive left for 1.8 miles to 14th Court. Follow the roadway left, and you will see the sign marking the entrance driveway to the Center. Turn right and proceed up the hill.

SPEAKER...
